Tour of the Mansion by Docent at 10:00 am

The Queen Anne style Victorian mansion was built in 1891-93 at a cost of \$35,000 to \$50,000. It was designed by the same Milwaukee architects who designed the Pabst Mansion in Milwaukee.

View Table Setting Exhibit at 11:00 am

The first table setting Exhibit at the Rahr-West was introduced more than 30 years ago by Ruth West. The exhibit originally featured traditional table settings of fine china and crystal but has taken on a life of its own.
